**4-1-1 WRITE-IN AFFIDAVITS OF INTENT.**

No write-in vote for any municipal office shall be counted at any election unless an Affidavit of Intent has been filed with the Town Clerk by the person whose name is written in, 34 days before the day of the election, indicating that such person desires the office and is qualified to assume the duties of that office if elected. (Ord 3-2011)

**4-1-2 CANCELLATION OF ELECTION .**

(A) If the only matter before the voters at any election is the election of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the 33rd day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filed at such election, including candidates filing Affidavits of Intent, the Town Clerk shall cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected. Upon such resolution the candidates shall be deemed elected. (Ord 3-2011)

(B) Notice of such cancellation shall be published, if possible and shall be posted at each polling place and at one other public place. (Ord 3-1998)

**4-1-3 REVISED DATES .** (Subsection added by Ord 3-2011)

(A) The following dates are established in lieu of the dates set out in the Colorado Municipal Election Code.

- (1) Nomination petitions may be circulated and signed beginning on the 64<sup>th</sup> day before the election and ending on the 46<sup>th</sup> day before the election, and must be filed with the clerk no later than the 46<sup>th</sup> day before the election.
- (2) Affidavits withdrawing a nomination pursuant to CRS 31-10-303, must be filed with the clerk no later than 39 days before the election.
- (3) Any certificate of nomination to fill a vacancy shall be filed with the clerk no later than the 34<sup>th</sup> day before the election, pursuant to CRS 31-10-304.
- (4) Amended petitions filed pursuant to CRS 31-10-302(4) are due 36 days before the election.

(B) Except for the above changes in dates, the provisions of the Colorado Municipal Election Code shall remain applicable to Town elections except as otherwise provided in the Town Charter or Ordinances.
