

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIDGWAY,  
COLORADO, ADOPTING THE 2020 OURAY COUNTY COVID-19 ECONOMIC  
RESILIENCY STUDY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Ridgway, Colorado (the “Town”) is a home rule municipality and political subdivision of the State of Colorado organized and existing under a home rule charter pursuant to Article XX of the Constitution of the State; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town, City of Ouray and Ouray County continue to navigate the challenges and impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on our community and local economy; and

**WHEREAS**, Economic and Planning Systems, Inc. was retained to develop the *2020 Ouray County COVID-19 Economic Resiliency Study* (the “Study”); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Study is to provide an evaluation of Ouray County’s economic and fiscal conditions and to provide clarity about the impacts attributed to COVID-19 in 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Study also includes information related to resources, which can be used as a guide for ways the community can position itself for future challenges to the system; and

**WHEREAS**, Town of Ridgway officials and staff will consider the actions and recommendations from the Study in order to improve economic conditions as we move past the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ridgway Town Council finds that the Study will promote the health, safety and general welfare of the Ridgway community.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ridgway Town Council hereby adopts the 2020 Ouray County COVID-19 Economic Resiliency Study, attached as Exhibit A.
