Ridgway Youth Advisory Council Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, April 13, 2022



1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Mayor Anna Bartschi called the meeting to order at 3:22 p.m. and Youth Advisory Council (YAC) members present were Cooper Ahern, Kayla Bolane, Maizy Gordon, Gillian Jordan, Indigo Krois, River Randolph and Kaitlyn Wikelmann. Mayor John Clark, Councilor Kevin Grambley, and Town Manager Preston Neill were also present. Eleni Wallin arrived at the meeting at 3:26 p.m.

2. Approval of Minutes from March 14, 2022

Indigo made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 14, 2022 meeting. Cooper seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

3. Presentation from Ridgway Community Garden

Agnieszka Przeszlowska, President of the Ridgway Community Garden, gave a presentation on Community Garden operations and activities.

4. Update regarding Community Suggestion Boxes

YAC members presented one of the completed suggestion boxes that had been constructed by the High School shop teacher.
