Ridgway Closes Town Hall to the Public; Rescinds Stage 1 Fire Restrictions

Ridgway, CO – At the November 19th Special meeting of the Ridgway Town Council, the Town Council voted to close Ridgway Town Hall to the public when Ouray County’s status on the state’s COVID Dial is Level Orange “Safer at Home – High Risk”, Level Red “Stay at Home”, or Level Purple “Extreme Risk”. Ouray County has been in Level Orange since November 16th. Town services and operations will continue as normal. The Town Council also voted to rescind “Stage 1” fire restrictions within the Town of Ridgway. The Town Council based their decision on the amount of current fire activity around the state, predicted weather, and current moisture levels.
