Water service outages planned for the nights of October 9th and October 14th

Ridgway, CO – Water service outages will take place the nights of Thursday, October 9th and Tuesday, October 14th for all Ridgway water customers.

In order for Ridgway Valley Enterprises (Ridgway Valley), on behalf of the Town of Ridgway, to move forward to the next stages of the <u>Ductile Iron Pipe Replacement Project</u>, they need to tie in the brand new segment of C900 PVC pipe into the pressure reducing station located at the south end of S Amelia St. This work will



require a temporary water service outage on the night of Thursday, October 9th. The work is expected to take several hours and will occur between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

Similarly, on the night of Tuesday, October 14th, Ridgway Valley will put a temporary water line in service from the pressure reducing station located at the south end of S Amelia St. to Sabeta Dr., which will require another temporary water service outage. The work is also expected to take several hours and will occur between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

The Town of Ridgway apologizes for any inconvenience to our customers and asks for your patience as we complete this important work. Please know that crew members will strive to minimize the outages as much as possible.
