Water service outage planned for the night of November 4th

Ridgway, CO – A water service outage will take place the night Tuesday, November 4th for all Ridgway water customers.

In order for Ridgway Valley Enterprises (Ridgway Valley), on behalf of the Town of Ridgway, to wrap up work on the <u>Ductile Iron Pipe Replacement Project</u> for the 2025 construction season, they need to tie in the brand new segment of C900 PVC pipe into the intersection of S Amelia St. and Sabeta Dr. This work will require a



temporary water service outage on the night of Tuesday, November 4th. The work is expected to take several hours and will occur between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. This will be the last water outage related to this Project for the remainder of 2025. Ridgway Valley will return to Ridgway in March of 2026 to finish the remaining stages of the Project.

The Town of Ridgway apologizes for any inconvenience to our customers and asks for your patience as we complete this important work. Please know that crew members will strive to minimize the outages as much as possible.
