REMINDER: Water service outage planned for tonight

Ridgway, CO - A water service outage will take place tonight (Tuesday, October 14th) for all Ridgway water customers.

In order for Ridgway Valley Enterprises (Ridgway Valley), on behalf of the Town of Ridgway, to move forward to the next stages of the <u>Ductile Iron Pipe Replacement Project</u>, they need put a temporary water line in service from the pressure reducing station located at the south end of S Amelia St. to Sabeta Dr., which will require



another temporary water service outage. The work is also expected to take several hours and will occur between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

The Town of Ridgway apologizes for any inconvenience to our customers and asks for your patience as we complete this important work. Please know that crew members will strive to minimize the outages as much as possible.
